The Technical Instructions represent the official legislative provisions for the transport of dangerous goods by air for all member states globally (and the airlines registered within those states).

The Emergency Response Guidance publication references these Instructions in an easy-to-use format for use in the event of an incident involving Dangerous Goods on board an aircraft. This provides a basis for the rapid response required in avoiding or reducing physical and financial loss which can result from a dangerous goods incident on board an aircraft.
